



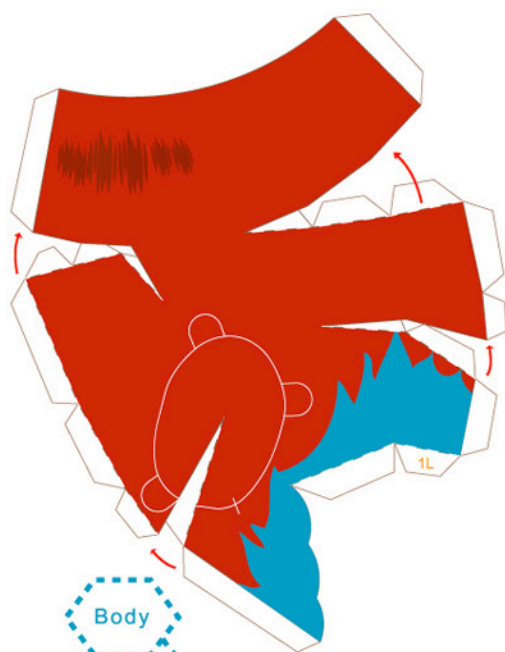
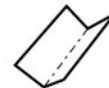

--- Outward fold

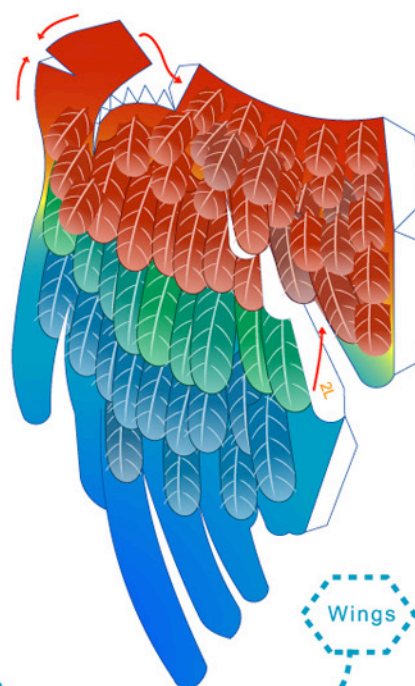
--- Inward fold

Same on the other side



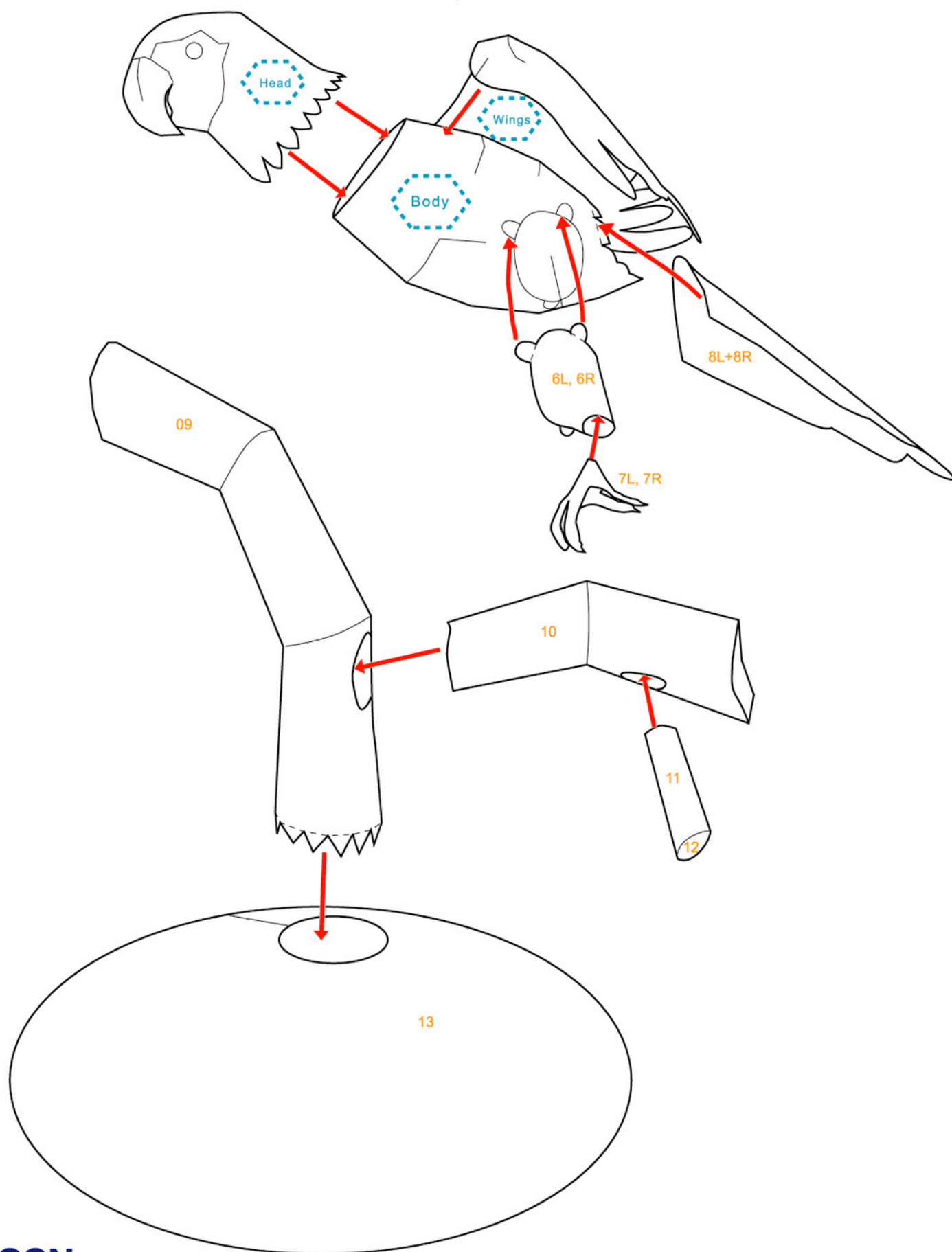

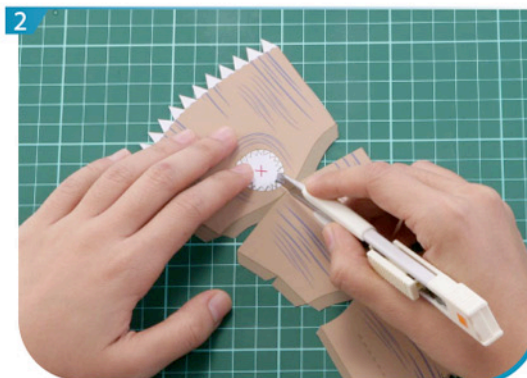
Assembly Instructions



Basic Steps



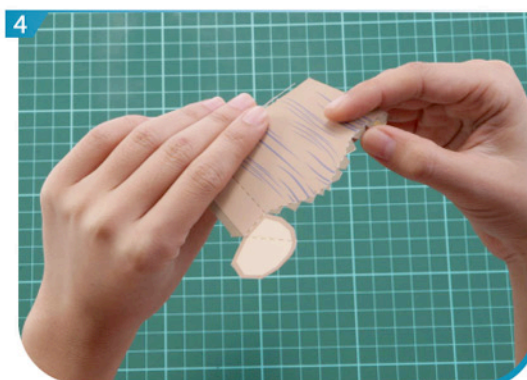
Separate all parts along the lines. Mark their identity on the back to avoid confusion.



Cut out parts which are marked with an 'x'.



Use a pen whose ink has dried out, or a tracer, to trace lines first.

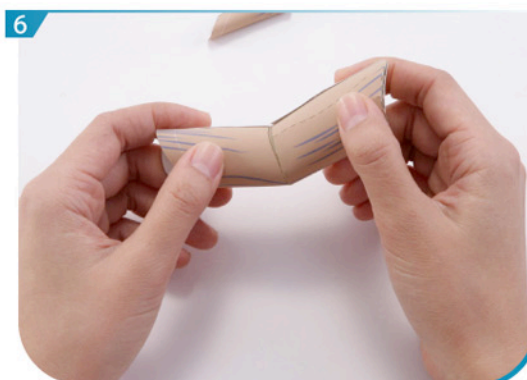


Fold all parts along the lines.

Trunk and base



First use a cylindrical pen to roll 09, 10 and 11.



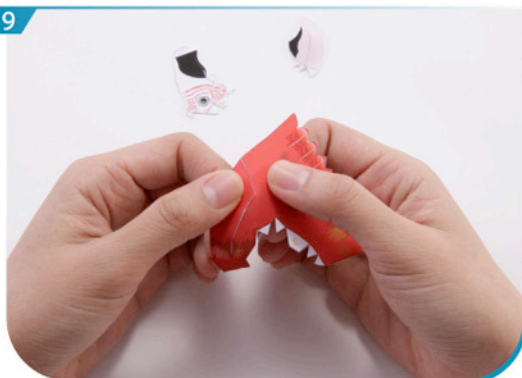
Glue the above parts and 12 together according to the assembly instructions to form the trunk.



Glue 13 on to the base.
Glue the trunk and the base together.

Fold and glue 3L, 4L and 5L respectively.

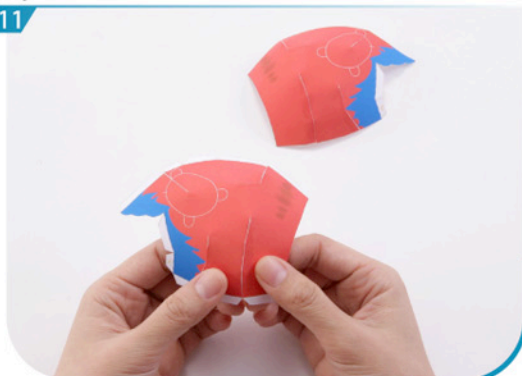

Glue the above parts together according to the assembly instructions to form the left part of the head.
The instructions for the right part of the head (3R, 4R and 5R) are the same as above.

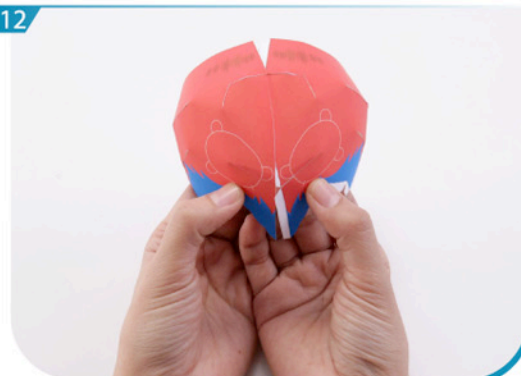
Body

Fold and glue 1L and 1R respectively.

Glue the above parts together according to the assembly instructions to form the body.

Tail

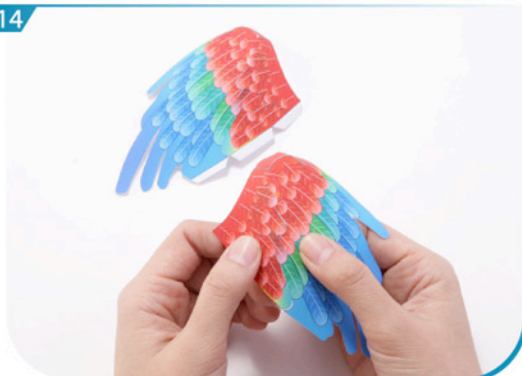

Glue 8R and 8L together, then cut them into a tail

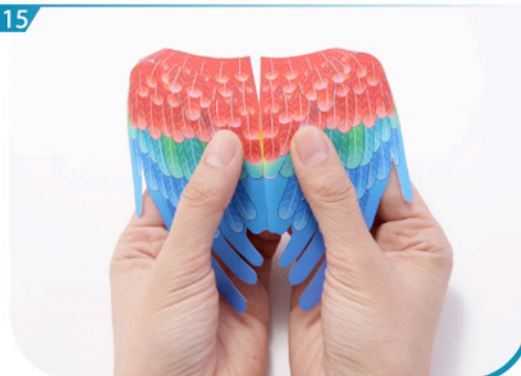
Wings

Fold and glue 2R and 2L respectively.

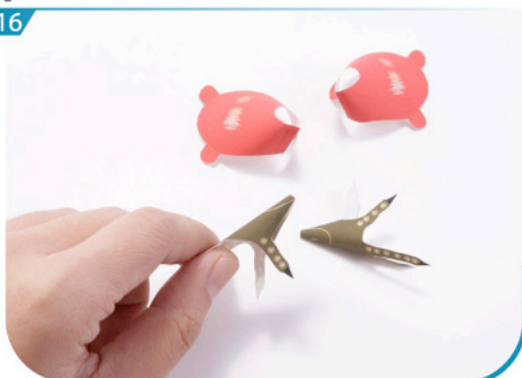


Glue the above parts together according to the assembly instructions to form a pair of wings.



Legs

Roll and glue 6L and 7L respectively to form the left leg.
The instructions for the right leg (6R and 6L) are the same as above.

Finally, assemble all the parts, and a colourful parrot is ready to fly and talk!
